A Message from Pastor Denvil

God is NOT Finished

The season of Lent begins February 22nd. Lent is a season of honest reflection and renewed hope—a time when we face what is broken and trust that God is still at work. This year, our Lenten journey is shaped by a simple but powerful truth: **God is Not Finished.**

As we near the end of the rebuilding of our sanctuary, we will hear the story of Nehemiah. In the book of Nehemiah, God's people stand amid ruins. The walls of Jerusalem are broken, the people are discouraged, and the future feels uncertain. Nehemiah feels called to lead God's people through a rebuilding process—to rebuild the walls of the city so that the people could gather in peace. His journey begins in prayer. As Nehemiah turns to God in repentance and trust, we are reminded that renewal always starts when God's people seek Him honestly and wholeheartedly. What looks like the end is often the place where God begins His next work.

A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR DENVIL continued

God is Not Finished

As the story unfolds, we see that God's work continues through trust, perseverance, and faith in the face of opposition and weariness. But God's concern for the people of Israel was more than rebuilding the temple, or the walls, or the city of Jerusalem. The people heard God's call to rebuild, but God was not finished there. God was restoring a people who would once again live for His purposes and reflect His glory.

This Lenten theme speaks not only to Israel's story, but to our own. God cares about you as an individual with your own hurts, sins, and sorrows. God wants to heal your brokenness, forgive your sins, and make you whole. But God is not finished there. Renewal is never just for us; it is always meant to serve God's redeeming work in the world.

Lent ultimately carries us to the heart of the gospel. The greatest declaration that God is not finished comes at Easter. When the world believed death had the final word, God raised Jesus from the grave. The resurrection proclaims that sin does not win, despair does not last, and death is not the end. Because the tomb is empty, God's promises are still true, and His work of redemption continues.

As we journey through Lent toward Easter, we do so with hope and confidence—trusting that the God who was faithful in Jerusalem, faithful in Christ, and faithful throughout history is still at work today. God is not finished with His world. **God is not finished with His church. And God is not finished with you.**




KINGDOM KIDS CONTINUED
